ANTI-LITTER BY-LAWS

1. **Title** – These by-laws may be cited as the Hwange Local Board (Anti – litter By-Laws 2005.

2. **Application**

These –Laws shall apply to the Council area.

3. **Interpretation**

In these By-Laws:-

“Council” means the Hwange Local Board.

“Litter” includes any container, wrapping cartons, cigarette-packets, paper, vegetable matter, garden waste. Hedge-clippings, dead animals, ash, tins, rubble, bricks, stone and any other matter or substance which is unwholesome, offensive or untidy.

“Public Place” includes any bridge, enclosure, foot path, garden, park, garage, car park, open space pavement, road, service-lane, side walk or any other area vested in or controlled by the Council to which the public or any section of the public has access.

4. **Prohibition of illegal dumping of litter**

No person shall deposit or abandon or cause or permit to be deposited or abandoned any litter in a public place, except in a Receptacle specially provided for the receipt of such litter.

5. **Offences** :- Anyone who contravenes these By-Laws shall be guilty of an offence and liable to pay the fines stipulated by Council.

6. **Fines**

(a) Street Littering (bus tickets, food wrappers, cigarette packs etc)	\$30.00
(b) Littering at Lay-byes, Bus Stops and open spaces	\$30.00
(c) Rubbish from vehicle	\$30.00
(d) Dumping of garden refuse or building rubble Where prohibited.	\$20.79
(e) Dumping of dead animals, filth or substance which is unwholesome, offensive or untidy.	\$33.00
